## Cable Locks, Security Cables, and Security Chains

Cable Locks-Flexible cables wrap around equipment and an anchor point and lock with a key, combination, or both. They are used with items that cannot be secured with a padlock. Vinyl coating helps prevent scratching. 6JD76 and 6JD75 have integrated locks.
Security Cables-Flexible cables wrap around large or bulky items like fences and are secured with a padlock. 3NY54 and 3 UU 68 Python patented locks hold cable at any position.

Braided steel wire cable has looped ends for use with U-locks or padlocks. Vinyl coated.

Security Chains-Tough chains are secured with a padlock to restrict access to high-value items. They are enclosed in a nylon sleeve that protects the chain from damage.
Removable Steel Shackle Padlock—U-shaped lock has double-locking hardened steel removable shackle, heavy-duty cable and chain, and 7-pin tubular cylinder.
